WHY AM I BEING INVITED TO TAKE PART IN THIS RESEARCH? It is

important to learn about how music can help kids learn. Seeing how you might be able to remember things using music can help us understand more about that.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS

STUDY? The purpose of this study is to see if kids remember words better when they hear them as a song.

WHO IS DOING THE STUDY?

David Knott, MT-BC (Board-Certified Music Therapist) is doing the study. David is studying how to use music to help people.

WHERE WILL THE STUDY TAKE PLACE?

You will have to come to a private office in the Eastlake neighborhood of Seattle to do the test.

AND HOW LONG WILL IT LAST?

You and your parent will spend less than 60 minutes at the test site.
