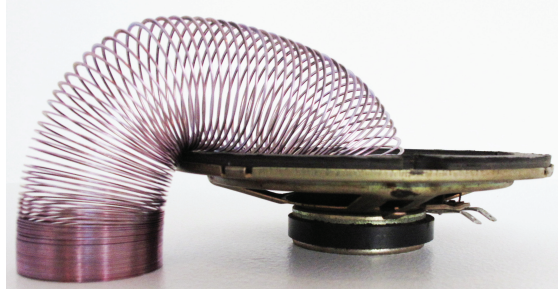


# Jack Straw and AVIA Youth Sound Art Workshop

Join us in the studios at Jack Straw Cultural Center for a hands-on art-making workshop in conjunction with the Jack Straw New Media Gallery installation *Brain Goreng*. This workshop is open to students of all ages.

## Slinky Sound Workshop: Saturday, May 12 1-4pm

Springs were used in the early days of sound reproduction to simulate the sound of an instrument in a large room. Springs can become a kind of antenna, picking up the sounds of the environment. When sound is sent through the springs, they make it possible to *feel* the sound.

Participants will begin with listening and sounding games and exercises, explore the textures and sound-making possibilities of springs, and finally record their own sound compositions in the studio. Through listening and touch, amplified springs will allow participants opportunities to practice listening exercises, as well as create their own short, sound-based pieces using both improvisational and compositional techniques.
